Navelink – our history

- December 2019, formed by Kongsberg, SAAB and Wärtsilä
- December 2019, Combitech AB tasked to govern
- December 2019, Swedish Maritime Administration, SMA, as in lead body of EU-projects (STM-projects) joined
- 31 December 2019, first milestone was met
- January 2020, Navelink joined the Maritime Connectivity Consortium as Navelink is based on the Maritime Connectivity Platform (MCP)
- 29 February 2020, initial capability, enrolment possible
- 1 April, 2020 planned full capability

Service development enrolment

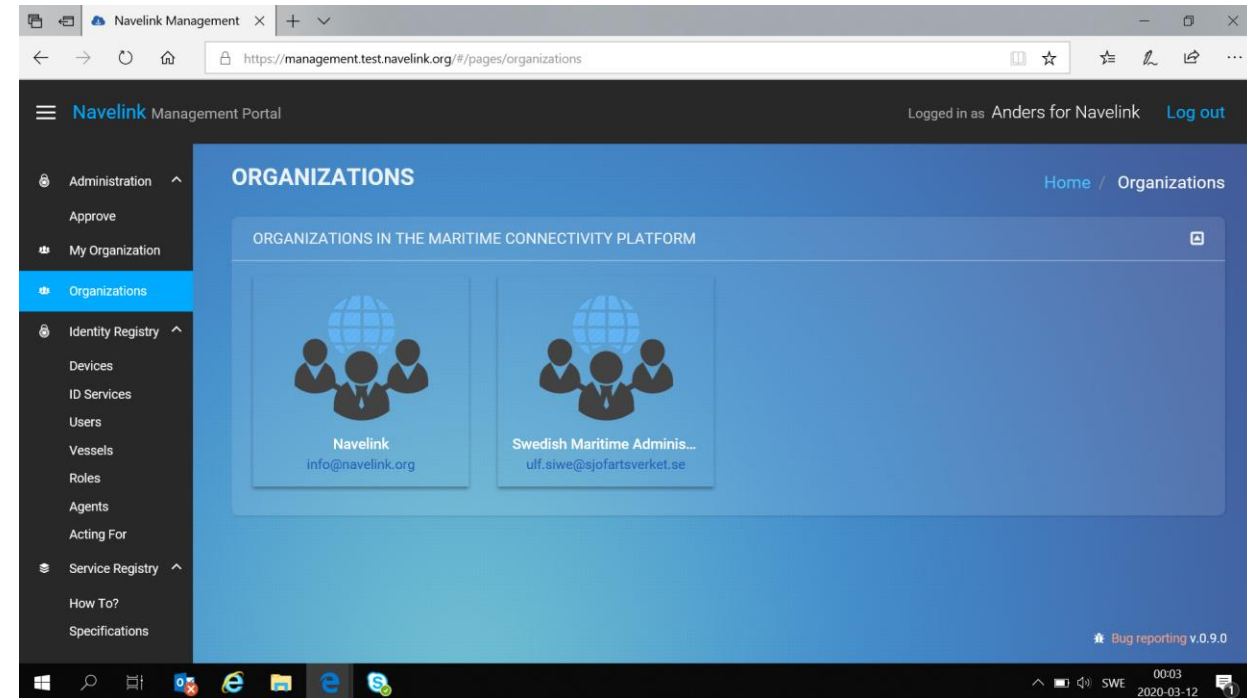
- You are a service developer
