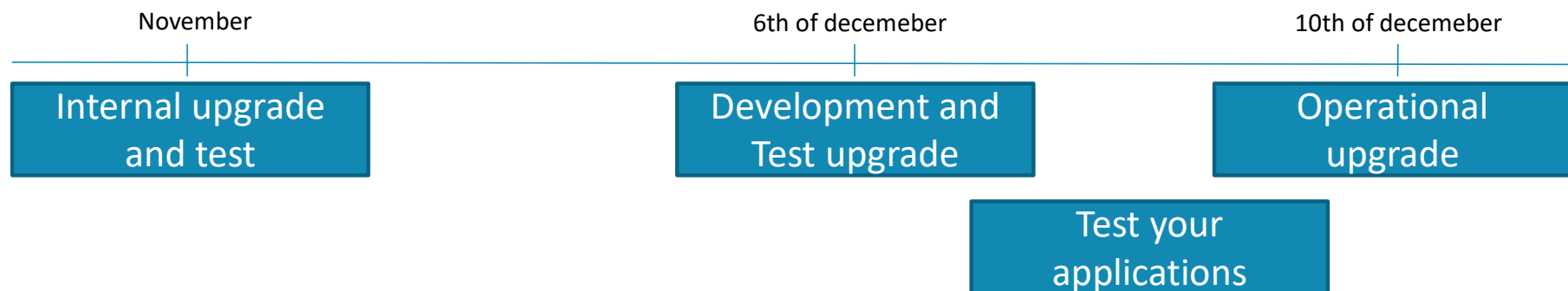

MCP 1.0.0 release notes

- Alignment with good RESTful principles
 - Includes returning HTTP 201 instead of 200 on POST calls and include a URL to the created resource in the response
- Implemented more fine grained functionality of the Agent feature
 - All existing agents will have the ORG_ADMIN role
- All endpoints that return JSON now set the Content-Type header as application/json instead of application/json;charset=UTF-8

MCP 1.0.0 on Navelink platform

- 6/12 -2021 Development and Test environment gets upgraded to 1.0.0
- Test your services.
- 10/12 -2021 Operational will be upgraded to 1.0.0



Best practice of Navelink features – Mikael/Marcus

- Issue certificates and generating local keys
- Service registry
 - Service Registration and URL field
 - Service Registry monitoring and common warnings
- VIS-Hotel
 - HMAC performance issues when payload get large

HOW-TO Use the Verification Service

In each environment there is a VIS Verification Service registered (actually one by SMA and one by Navelink)

- The documentation can be reached through the Management portal
Find the instance and select Download Document
- The VIS Verification Service works only for services based on VIS Technical Design
- The VIS verification Service will bounce back every (valid) message sent to it together with a TXT message.
- It's also possible to send a TXT message to the Verification Service to get a bunch of reference messages back. Change the body to RTZ, S124 or TXT depending on payload type wanted.
- Ensure the Certificate used is for the service you want the data sent to
- Be aware that absolute path may be required for CURL
- Be aware to adjust yellow parts to your data
